General Rules & Regulations

- **If Participating in Miss Photogenic: Photo must be submitted w/entry form and EXTRA \$10 registration payment (digital or print acceptable).**
- Any photo used in the Miss Photogenic competition must portray the contestant's age--low cut clothing, over done make-up and large earrings is not advisable, especially on the younger contestants.
- Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated.
- Only the contestant and one chaperone are allowed in the dressing areas.
- Contestants must be on time for scheduled rehearsals and competitions. We cannot delay the rehearsals or competitions to wait for any contestant. All contestants must attend rehearsal.
- Contestant numbers should be worn during all on-stage competitions on the left side of the waistband.
- Judges make final decision on disqualifications due to poor sportsmanship, inappropriate clothing, misconduct, etc.
- Entry fees and all other fees paid will NOT be refunded due to a disqualification, cancellation, or not participating the day of the event.

Specific Clothing Guidelines

- Sexy overdone clothing is not acceptable.
- No competition clothing can have open sides of any kind.
- No midriffs are permitted to show in any outfit for all age groups.
- No extremely low necklines in a phase of the competition.
- No disrobing or garment removal in any phase of competition.
- No visual drawings on the body are allowed. (i.e. tattoos)
- No jewelry of any kind will be allowed.
- No extremely tight fitting gowns in any age group.
- **Ages 3-9** will compete in Party Dress competition. The length of the dress should not be long. The acceptable length is any where from mid-thigh to mid-calf. This age group cannot appear in party dress with the back lower than the contestants' shoulder blades.
- **Ages 10-18** will compete in Evening Gown competition. Each contestant must wear a floor length gown, which is AGE appropriate.
- **Party Dress/Evening Gown** should be age appropriate in style and adornments. No side midriff cutouts, indecent back exposure and no split skirts above the knees in Evening gown.
- There are no set rules for panty hose or socks for any age. Strapless and/or one shoulder strapped dresses are not permitted and all straps must be at least a 1" minimum width. Straps must be made of solid material. See through tool or chiffon is not considered a solid strap and a 1" strap will need to be added to comply with rulings.
- Halter-tops can be worn with 1" straps. The back of the dress must follow clothing requirements.
- **Sportswear must be an active or dressy outfit.** No skirts, dresses, swimsuits, glittery costumes, rhinestones or sequins will be allowed. Skorts can be worn; however, they must resemble shorts in some way. They cannot simply wear a skirt with shorts or bloomers underneath.
